STEPS TO RECEIVING SUMMER FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE

Priority Dates: **Summer I/Dual – April 20, 2007** **Summer II – June 1, 2007**

- I. Complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) for 2006-07 online at www.fafsa.ed.gov. Please indicate our school code of 002950 in section six. The Department of Education will forward a paper Student Aid Report to the address listed on the FAFSA and an electronic file to the institution within 1 week. Please verify that North Carolina Central University is listed on the Student Aid Report (SAR). The expiration date for the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) for 2006-07 is June 30th. Students attending the second session of summer school should closely monitor the deadline date to ensure that the FAFSA is processed.
- II. Complete the NCCU Summer School Financial Aid Application to receive financial assistance for summer school. Applications are available on March 20, 2007 at www.nccu.edu/ssa and in our office. Students must be registered for summer school in the summer sessions desired, prior to submitting the summer school application. The financial aid award will be based on the registered session (Summer I, II, or I and II) and hours at the time the summer school application is processed by our office. If you desire financial assistance for both sessions of summer school, please make certain that you are registered for Summer I and II before submitting the NCCU Summer School Financial Aid Application.
- III. Types of financial aid available during the summer vary based on the student remaining eligibility for Pell Grant and loans. To qualify for a student or parent loan, you must be enrolled on at least a half-time basis, undergraduates six (6) hours and graduates four and one-half (4.5) hours. If there is a class schedule change that results in enrollment of less than half-time, the Stafford and/or plus loans will be cancelled.
- IV. Initial award notifications will be mailed to the address indicated on the summer school application. Students are expected to visit Eagles Online for award updates and changes including reductions and cancellations.
- V. Student and parent loans require additional steps.
 1. Desired loans must be accepted online or a signed award letter should be provided to our office. For parent loans, a plus loan confirmation form must be
 2. The loan entrance counseling session is required for new and transfer students (undergraduates, graduates and professional).
 3. A valid master promissory note is needed for each borrower (student and parent). You may complete the master promissory note(s) at <http://dlenote>.
