

# Rewarding your hard work

North Carolina Central University's Office of Transfer Services offers scholarship opportunities for qualified full-time and part-time transfer students (including distance education transfer students) who complete the Associate of Arts, Associate of Science, or Associate of Applied Science degree programs from a North Carolina community college. The NCCU Community College Transfer Scholarships are offered to North Carolina community college graduates who received their degrees within the past five years and present GPAs in the following ranges:



## On campus Transfer Students

GPA	Part-time (6 hrs.)	Part-time (9 hrs.)	Full-time (15 hrs.)
2.75 – 3.0	\$1,000 per year	\$1,500 per year	\$2,000 per year
3.1 – 3.5	\$1,250 per year	\$1,875 per year	\$2,500 per year
3.6 – 4.0	\$1,500 per year	\$2,250 per year	\$3,000 per year

## Distance Education Transfer Students

GPA	Part-time (6 hrs.)	Part-time (9 hrs.)	Full-time (15 hrs.)
2.75 – 3.0	\$500 per year	\$750 per year	\$1,000 per year
3.1 – 3.5	\$600 per year	\$900 per year	\$1,200 per year
3.6 – 4.0	\$700 per year	\$1,050 per year	\$1,400 per year

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# OFFICE OF TRANSFER SERVICES

## Application Process:

North Carolina Central University's (NCCU) Transfer Scholarship is a two-year scholarship for North Carolina Community College graduates who have been admitted to NCCU. A student may apply for the scholarship while making application to the University, however, the scholarship application will only be processed after the student is accepted to North Carolina Central University.

The transfer scholarship recipient must maintain a minimum 3.00 cumulative GPA while enrolled for two consecutive years (excluding summer school). Students who are awarded a scholarship with a GPA of 2.75 must have a GPA of 3.0 by the start of the second semester in order to maintain the scholarship. The transfer scholarship is offered on a first-come first-serve basis. Thus, not all students who apply are awarded scholarships. The number of scholarships awarded may vary from year to year.

**All transfer scholarships are for tuition and fees only; they do not cover orientation, or any other initial non-refundable deposits, application fees, supplies, or campus residential fees (room and board). Transfer students receiving other sources of financial aid excluding loans (grants, scholarships, etc.) that cover tuition and fees are not eligible for the Transfer Scholarship, but may be eligible for up to \$1,000 in a book voucher from the NCCU Bookstore.**

## What to submit:

- Completed transfer scholarship application
- Official North Carolina Community College transcript –
  - If you are submitting your application before receiving your final community college transcript, you may submit an unofficial transcript showing your current GPA. The final transcript must be received to be considered for a scholarship.
- Essay (typed – 500 words) – **Topic** based on your educational journey to this point; what positive experiences have prepared you to complete your Bachelors Degree at North Carolina Central University?
