# Basic Benefits for Fall 2012 & Spring 2013 UNC System-Wide Student Health Insurance Hard Waiver Plan

<u>Premium</u>: There is one rate for all students regardless of gender, age, or enrollment classification of undergraduate or graduate

- o \$ 709 per semester (the Plan is purchased by semester)
- o \$1,418 per year (this equates to \$118 per month)

### Policy Year

o Fall: August 1 - December 31

O Spring: January 1 - July 31

# In-Network Benefits Per Policy Year

- \$100,000 per Injury / illness maximum medical benefit per policy year, unlimited lifetime maximum
- \$300 annual deductible, waived at Student Health Center
- \$20 Doctor visit co-pay outside Student Health Center; plus 20% coinsurance
- \$300 co-pay for ER visits; waived if admitted to the hospital
   \$75 co-pay for Urgent Care; waived if referred to ER
- \$500 injection & immunization benefit
- Anesthesia benefit: 80% of PPO allowance
- \$4,000 out-of-pocket maximum

#### Pharmacy Benefit

- \$100,000 pharmacy benefit up to the aggregate policy maximum per policy year
  - o \$10 prescription co-pay at Student Health Center Pharmacy
  - o \$ 0 contraceptive co-pay at Student Health Center Pharmacy
- Outside pharmacy
  - o \$25 co-pay for generic drugs
  - o \$50 co-pay for formulary drugs
  - o \$100 co-pay for brand based on 3-tier formulary (i.e., specialty drugs); all specialty drugs go through Ascend, an Informed Rx Pharmacy

## Preventive Care/Wellness Benefit

- Covered up to the \$100,000 aggregate policy maximum per policy year
  - O Benefits include no co-pay or deductible for services performed at the campus Student Health Center or if not offered at a Student Health Center, an in-network provider
  - O For services not performed at the Student Health Center, normal co-pays & coinsurance apply

# Other Benefits

- Mental health benefit up to the \$100,000 policy maximum per policy year
  - O Subject to deductible, coinsurance and co-pay
- \$200 vision reimbursement benefit
- Nurse Hotline available 24 hours per day / 7 days per week
- Travel Assistance for Domestic and International Travel
