- -Camps may start as early 7:30 am and end by 6:00 pm daily.
- -Each Camp or Program's brochure or application will indicate the Age(s) of the target that will be served by the camp.
- -Each Camp or Program's brochure or application will cite the REQUIRED, IMPORTANT DOCUMENTS NECESSARY FOR A PARTICULAR CAMP OR PROGRAM. Such documents may require but are not limited to proof of age; Parent/Guardian primary and secondary contact information; Emergency contact information (other than parent or guardian); health insurance information; Physician and dentist contact information (address and telephone number); medical information (including any medications that taken daily by the camper); and please share any special needs or accommodations that your camper will need to be serviced with.

## <u>Registration Opened for Camps and Programs – March 2013</u>

The registration process for each Camp or Program has been outlined in the brochure and application information published. Therefore, camp registrations may start as early as March 2013 through August 2013. Camp and Program Coordinators will notify camp registrants and families at least 15 days of any camp cancellations. Coordinators will also notify the NCCU Office of Summer Programs and Outreach of any camp cancellations 15 days as well.

The Camp or Program has provided payment instructions via the brochure and application for each NCCU Summer Camp or Program. Special tuition scholarships for camps will be administered by the Camp Coordinator.
