General Admission Criteria for Master Level Programs

- On-line graduate admission application
- Application Fee - \$40.00
- Official transcripts (all colleges and universities attended)
- Entrance Exam Scores (no more than five yrs. old)
- At least two (2) letters of recommendation/support
- Statement of personal/professional purpose
- At least a bachelor's degree

NOTE: Please check directly with the office of the degree program to which you are applying to determine if any additional documents/materials are required to meet the degree program's admission criteria

Admissions Criteria for the Ph.D. in Integrated Biosciences

- On-line graduate admission application
- Application Fee - \$40.00
- Official transcripts (all colleges and universities attended)
- GRE scores (no older than 5 yrs.)
- Minimum 3.00 GPA
- Three (3) letters of recommendation/support
- Statement of research and professional purpose
- At least a bachelor's degree in biology, chemistry, biochemistry, pharmaceutical sciences, or related discipline
- Campus interview may be required

Additional Admission Criteria for International Students

- Financial Statement Certificate of Eligibility
- Bank Statement (must be notarized)
- A course-by-course evaluated transcript by an accredited U.S. agency
- TOEFL Scores (if English is second language)
- Permanent Residents may submit a copy of green card at the time of application submission; however, the actual green card must be brought to the appropriate admitting office for inspection by the Admissions Specialist before being fully admitted to the degree program
