Minimum Course Requirements (MCRs)

The MCRs for all University of North Carolina System

Institutions, including North Carolina Central University, are as follows:

- Four units of college prep English;
- Three units of science (one must be a lab science);
- Two units of social studies (one must be United States History);
- Two units of the same foreign language (example: Spanish I & II);
- Four units of mathematics (required are Algebra I, Geometry, Algebra II and a fourth unit higher than Algebra II).
