The NCCU Police Dept. is scheduled for an on-site assessment as part of a program to achieve accreditation by verifying it meets professional standards.

Administered by the Commission on Accreditation for Law Enforcement Agencies, Inc. (CALEA), the accreditation program requires agencies to comply with state-of-the-art standards in four basic areas: policy and procedures, administration, operations, and support services.

As part of the on-site assessment, agency employees and members of the community are invited to offer comments at a public information session November 30, 2015 at 6:00 PM. The session will be conducted in the Biomedical/Biotechnology Research Institute (BBRI) Building, 531 Nelson St. Durham, NC.
