STUDENT ACCOUNTS

Please read this explanation and be sure this statement of student account reaches the person responsible for payment. Remittance must be received in the Comptroller's Office no later than the due date given on the face of this statement. Installment payment options are available. Installment payment options must be arranged by the final day of all registration activities.

CHARGES

The charges on this statement of student account reflect the student's registration and housing status for the current semester. The charges are based on the student's total registered hours and housing status at the time the statement was printed.

CREDITS

Financial Aid and payments made for the current semester will be deducted from current charges.

Please note: The estimated financial aid shown on the face of this statement is not an actual financial aid payment. It is a financial aid award. A financial aid award is subject to change.

PREVIOUS BALANCE

This amount represents prior semester's activity. If the amount listed has a CR beside it, (for example: 100.00CR), this means it is a credit in the student's favor and will be deducted from current charges and it is reflected in the Total Amount Due. If the amount listed does not have a CR beside it, (for example: 100.00), this means it is a balance due from the prior semester. This balance will be added to current charges and it is reflected in the Total Amount Due.

CURRENT DUE/TOTAL AMOUNT DUE

This is the net amount currently due.

INTEREST CHARGE

Effective July 1, 2012, an annual interest charge of 5% will be applied to all unpaid past due balances with a portion of the interest charge being applied monthly.

ONE-TIME LATE PAYMENT PENALTY CHARGE

Effective July 1, 2014, a 10% one-time late payment penalty charge will be applied to all unpaid past due balances.

PAST DUE BALANCE

Unpaid past due balances will be sent to the collection agency.

INSTALLMENT PROCESSING FEE/INSTALLMENT LATE PAYMENT CHARGE

Unpaid balances after the last day of registration for that particular semester will be charged a one-time installment processing fee. Unpaid balances prior to pre-registration of the next semester can be charged up to (2) additional installment late payment charges.

TUITION SURCHARGE

In 1993, the North Carolina General Assembly (Senate Bill 27--Section 89b) enacted legislation directing the Board of Governor's to impose a 25% tuition surcharge on students who take more than 140 degree credit hours to complete the first undergraduate baccalaureate degree in a four-year program or more than 110% of the credit hours necessary to complete the degree in eight regular term semesters or the equivalent (or ten semester hours for 5 year programs).

Effective Fall 2010 Term, a 50% tuition surcharge will be imposed on students who take more than 140 degree credit hours to complete the first undergraduate baccalaureate degree in a four-year program or more than 110% of the credit hours necessary to complete the degree in eight regular term semesters or the equivalent (or ten semester hours for 5 year programs).
