*The Office of Undergraduate Admissions is located in the Admissions Center at the corner of Lawson and Lincoln Street. The address of the Admissions Center is 705 E. Lawson Street.*

**In order to accommodate our guests and ensure a successful campus visit experience, please note the following:**

- **Parking is limited on campus, we recommend that you arrive 20-minutes prior to your scheduled visit as well as park in the suggested area to avoid tickets or towing.**
- **We are unable to accommodate tour requests outside of our daily standard tour times.**
- **We are unable to accommodate Saturday or Sunday tours at this time**
- **We reserve the right to cancel your tour and suggest a self-guided tour should you arrive 15 minutes or more, after your scheduled tour begins.**
- **Our office is able to offer free parking to the first 10 tour guest vehicles (non-group tours). Please review parking below to find out how to retrieve your free parking pass.**

## **Group Tour Information:**

- **Our standard group tour size is 75 students.**
- **Groups larger than 75 students must contact our office 7-14 days in advance to be accommodated. Please note that our group tour limit is 150 students.**
- **Unfortunately, we will have to offer a self-guided tour to groups that arrive larger than what has been confirmed.**

We recommend that you become acquainted with campus prior to arrival. Note the location of the Welcome Center as well as the Latham parking deck.

## **Parking**

If you are driving, we recommend that you arrive to campus at least 20 minutes prior to your scheduled visit. Upon arrival, please park in the Latham Parking Deck where hourly parking is available. The lot is located directly under the University Bookstore at 705 East Lawson Street, Durham, NC 27701. A parking attendant will be present to accept your payment. The pay station accepts credit cards and cash. Please note that you are unable to park in the surface lot without a free parking pass obtained from Campus Police. You must park in the actual Latham Parking Deck to avoid tickets or towing. The admissions center is located in the Latham Parking Deck as well. We do not provide validation for parking.

## **Free Parking is Available**

Please note that we are able to offer free parking to our first 10 tour guest vehicles (non-group tours). Please note that guests must report to the campus police station to retrieve the free parking pass. We encourage guests to arrive early to provide additional time to retrieve the parking pass as you will need it before you are able to park and check-in for the tour.

The Free Parking Pass will be provided in exchange for your driver's license. At the conclusion of the tour, you will need to return the parking pass and retrieve your driver's license. The NCCU Police Department is located at 2010 Fayetteville St., Durham, NC 27707. Contact Number is 919-530-5023 or 530-6106. You may call ahead to see if free parking is still available for your scheduled tour time.

**Guests with free parking passes** can park in the Latham Surface Lot, just outside of the bookstore and parking deck. The Latham Surface lot sits directly across the street from the football & track field. Guests with free parking can also park in any "non-reserved" parking space on campus. You **may not** use the parking pass in the Latham Parking Deck. Should you enter the Latham Parking deck, you will be required to pay.

## **Group Tour Parking:**
