## Orientation Dates

### First-Time Freshmen

- June 15 – 16
- June 22 – 23
- July 6 – 7
- July 13 – 14
- July 27 – 28

### Transfer Students

- May 18
- June 14
- June 21
- July 12

(Additional orientation dates may be added to the schedule.)



## Is Orientation Mandatory?

During orientation, you will complete many of the steps needed for enrollment such as meeting with an academic advisor, getting your Eagle Card and registering for classes.

Students who are required to attend:

- 2016 High School graduates
- Transfer students
- Students 24 yrs or older with previous college history
- Possess bachelor's degree from another institution, seeking 2nd bachelor from NCCU

Students are **not** required to attend:

- International Students
- Distance Education Students
- Students readmitted to NCCU
- NCCU Undergraduates seeking 2nd degree

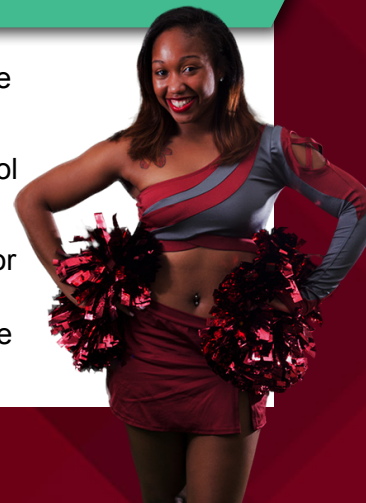


## How do I register for New Student Orientation?

Begin by creating a MyEOL account:

1. Go to [nccu.edu/myeol](http://nccu.edu/myeol) and enter the Banner ID number listed on your acceptance letter. (Starts with 820)
2. The Banner PIN # is your birthdate (MMDDYY).
3. Enter your last name (as it's written in your acceptance letter).

4. Click "verify my info" and you're official!
5. Now go back to [nccu.edu/myeol](http://nccu.edu/myeol) and log in.
6. Click "Enroll Now" to register for New Student Orientation. Pick a date and pack your bags. We can't wait to see you!



# MORE INFORMATION



## Where will we stay for Orientation?

*Freshmen* will stay in a residence hall. Bring clothing for the next day, a towel, toiletries, (soap, toothpaste, etc.) fitted and flat sheets and a pillow.

*Family* can stay on-campus (select your room and pay when you check in for orientation.) or a review the preferred hotel list at [nccu.edu/firstyear](http://nccu.edu/firstyear).



## Who should I bring with me?

Bring your family and support team to cheer you on! (It's not required, though.) They'll hear from academic departments, learn about student services and tour the campus while meeting other parents. Plus, they can ask questions and learn about upcoming NCCU parent and family programs.



## Can I change my Orientation date?

Absolutely! Just contact us and include the student's name, banner ID and phone number and we will help you reschedule.

*Please note there is a \$10 date change fee per session change.*



## What is the enrollment deposit?

This deposit holds your place at NCCU and covers the cost of your new student orientation. The non-refundable deposit amount is:

First-time freshman - \$225  
Transfer Students - \$150



## I DO NOT have to attend Orientation. How do I register for classes?

1. Email the Office of New Student Services at [newstudents@nccu.edu](mailto:newstudents@nccu.edu) to confirm that you are NOT required to attend orientation.
2. We will communicate with your school/college to set-up your advising appointment.
3. Your school/college will contact you to set-up the appointment at a time that is convenient for you.

Failure to follow these steps could cause you to miss important necessary information and may affect your graduation or course registration.
