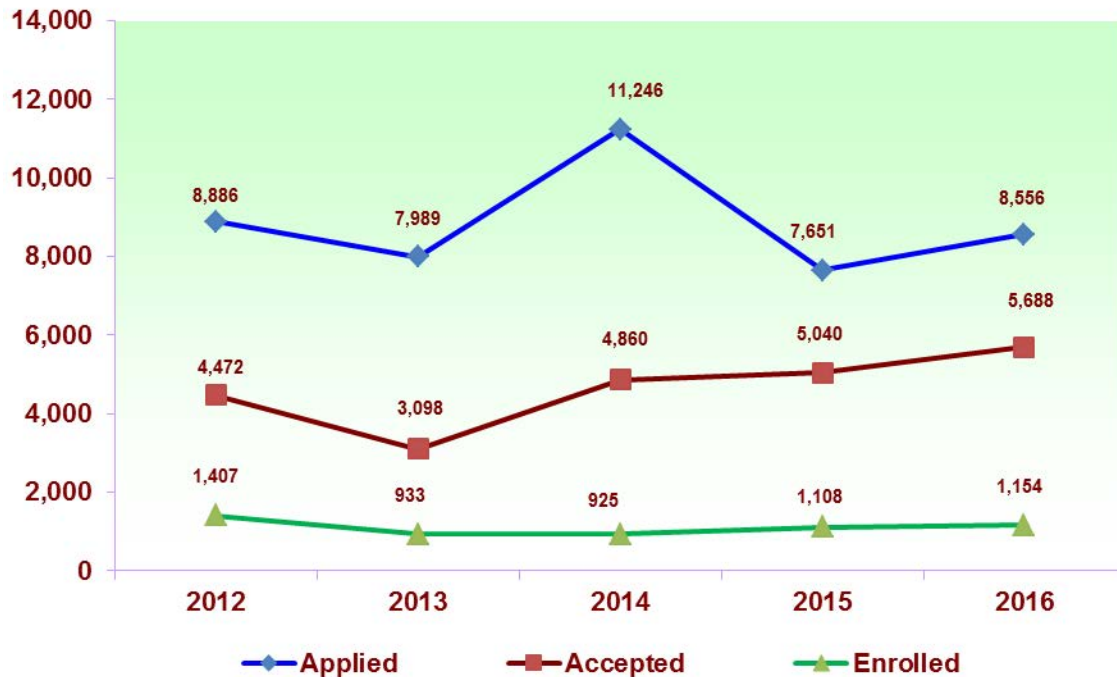

Fall 2012 – 2016



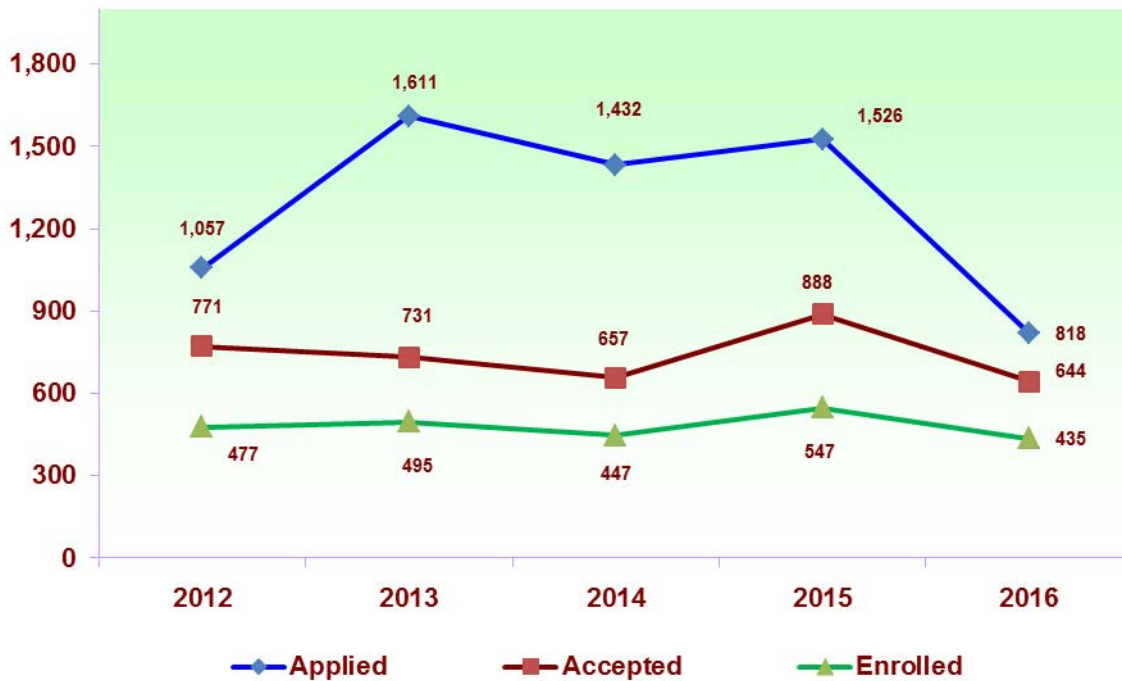

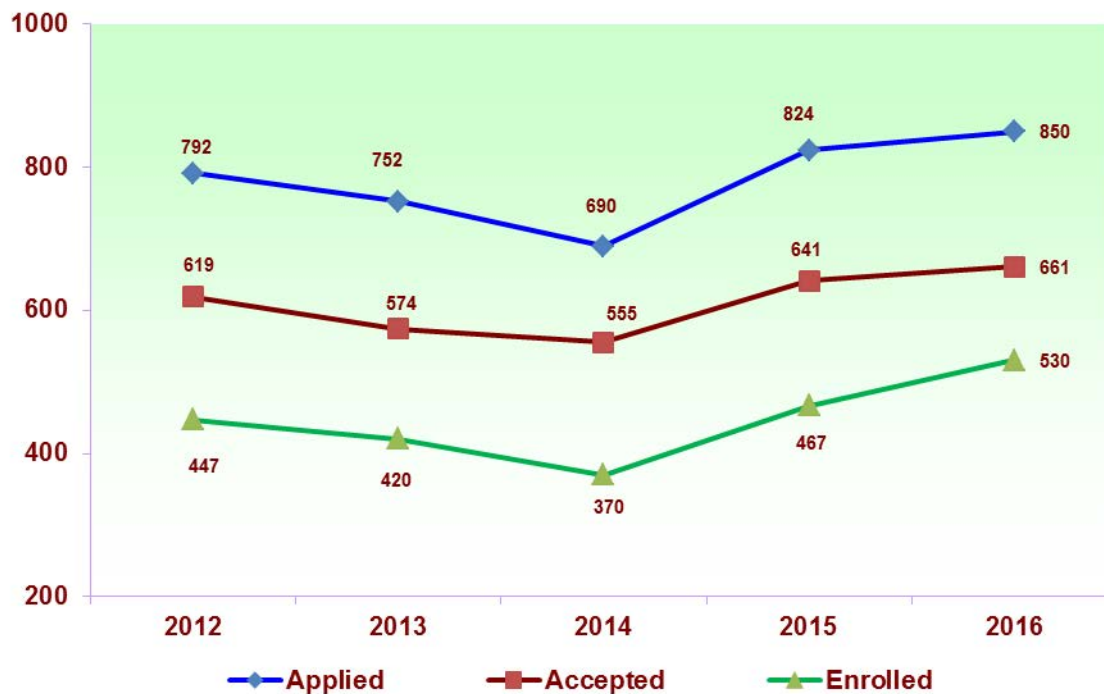

Fall 2012 – 2016



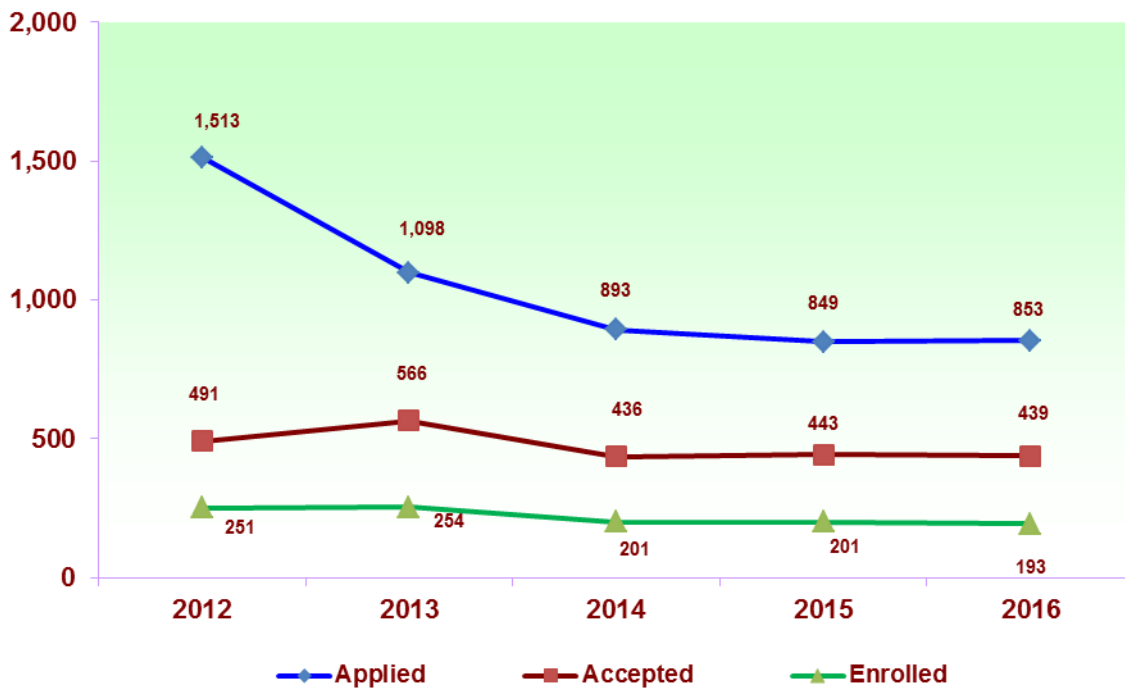

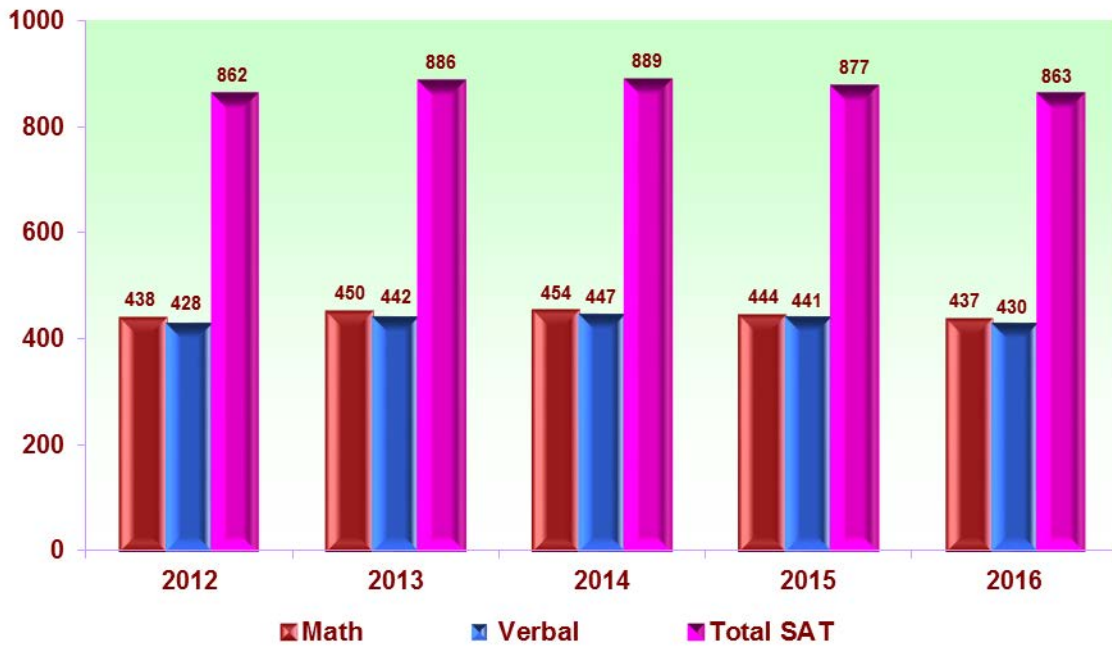

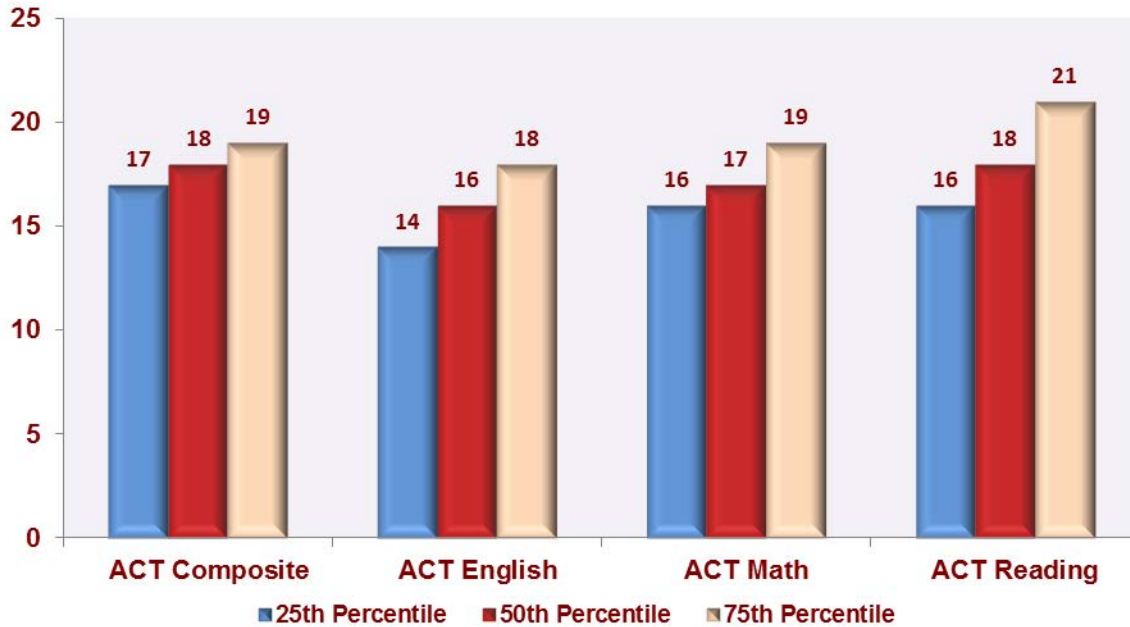

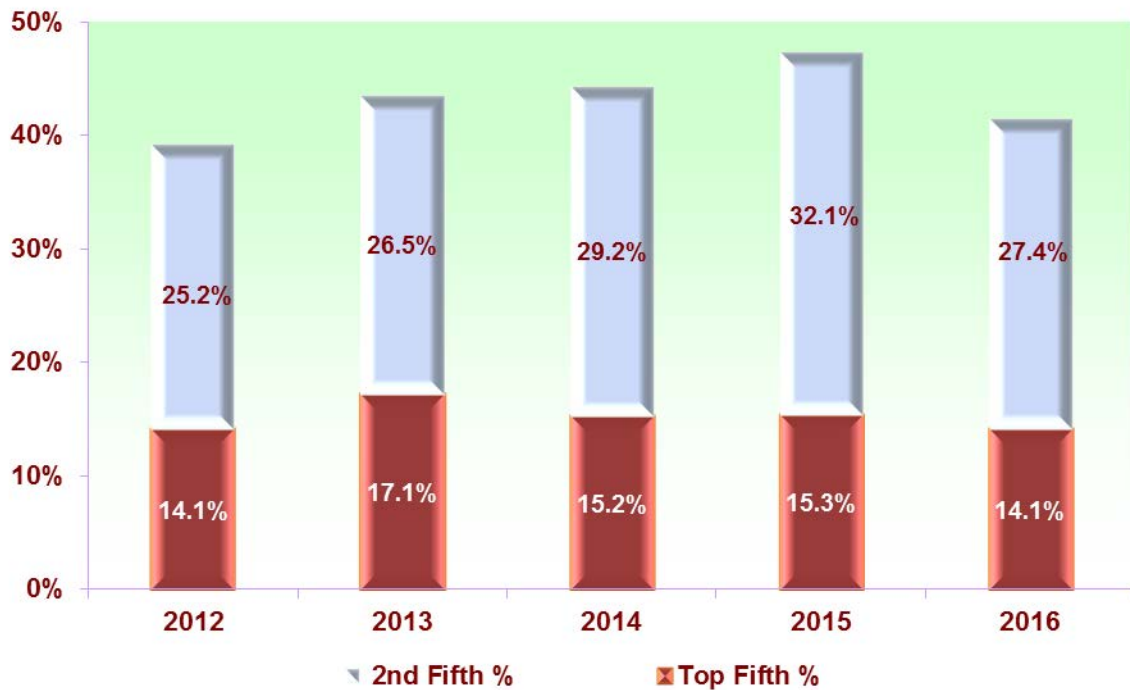

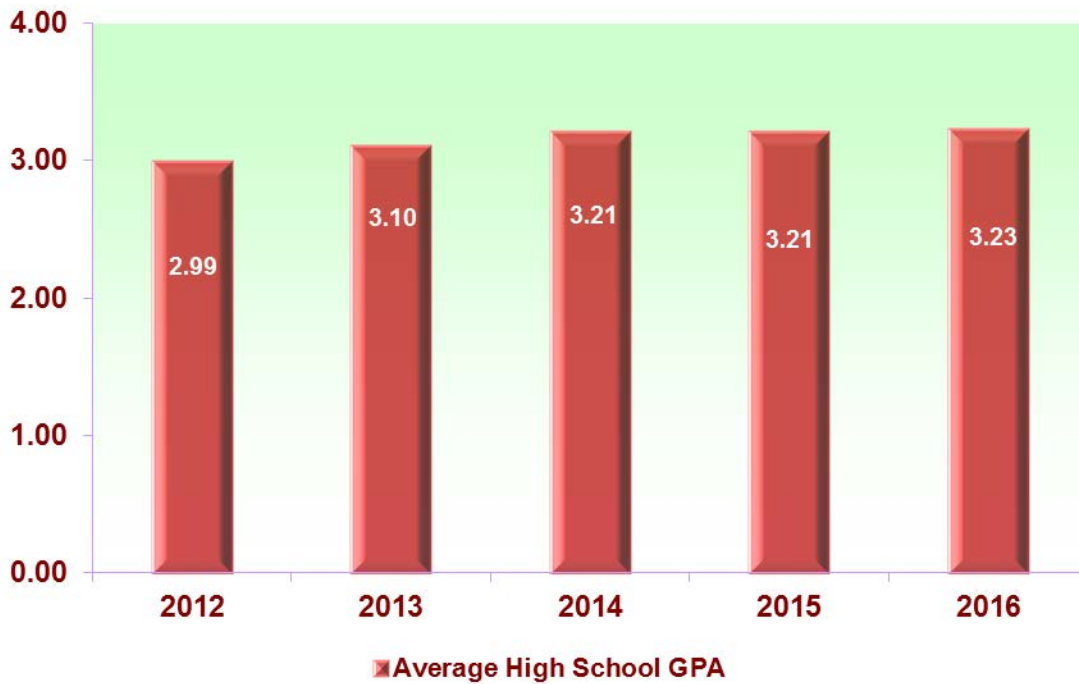

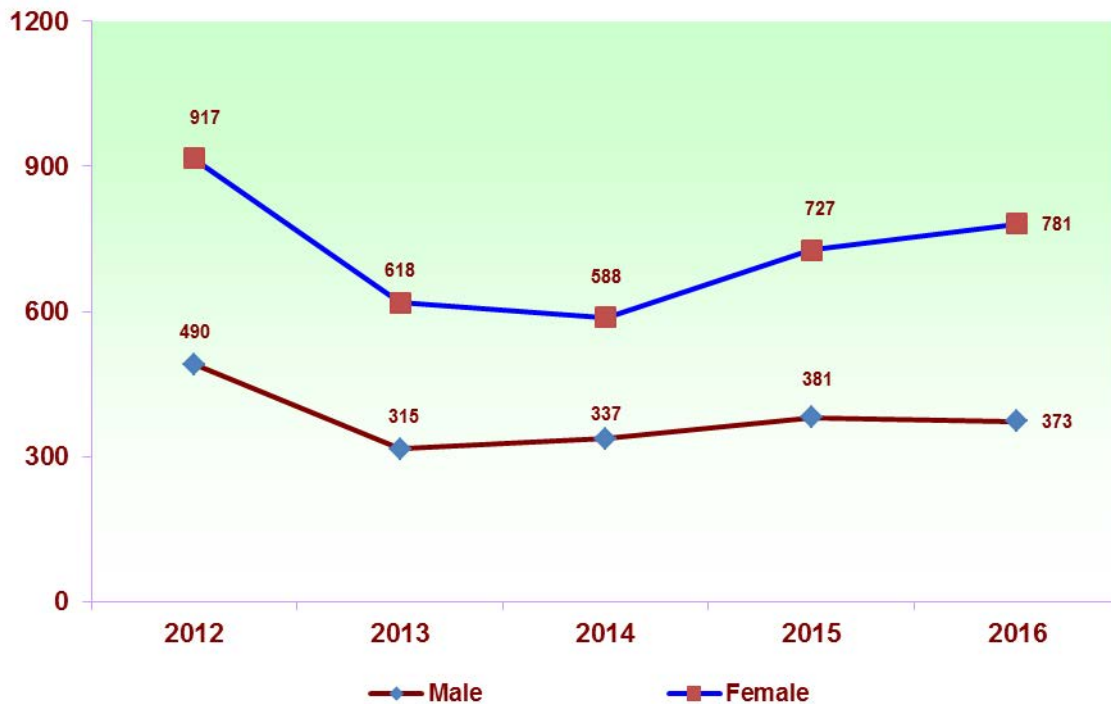

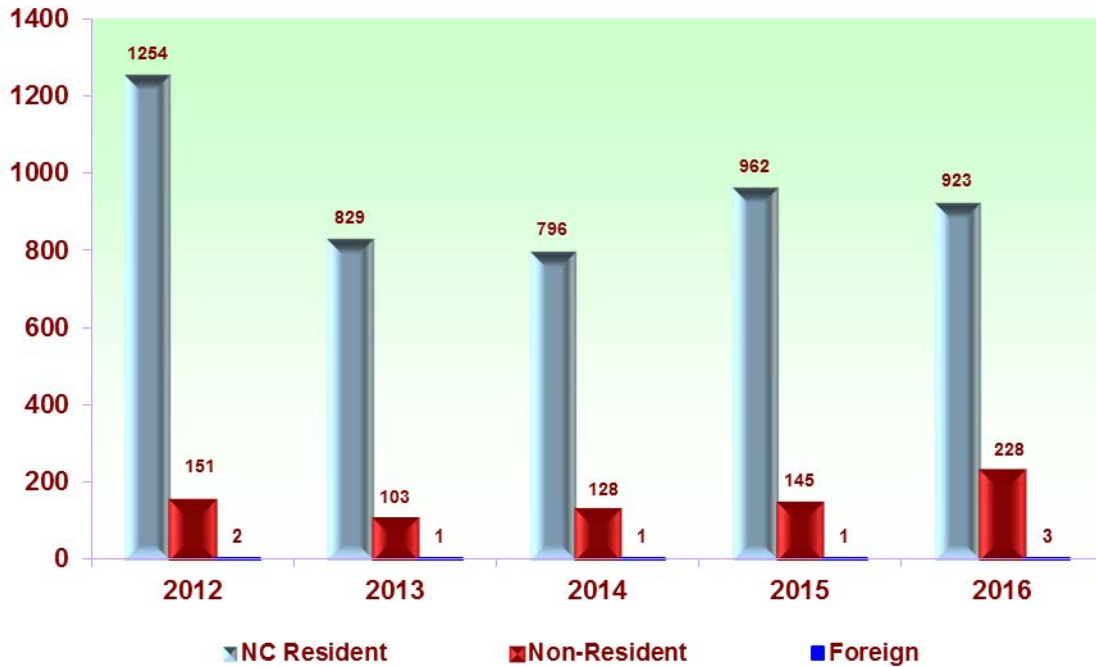
