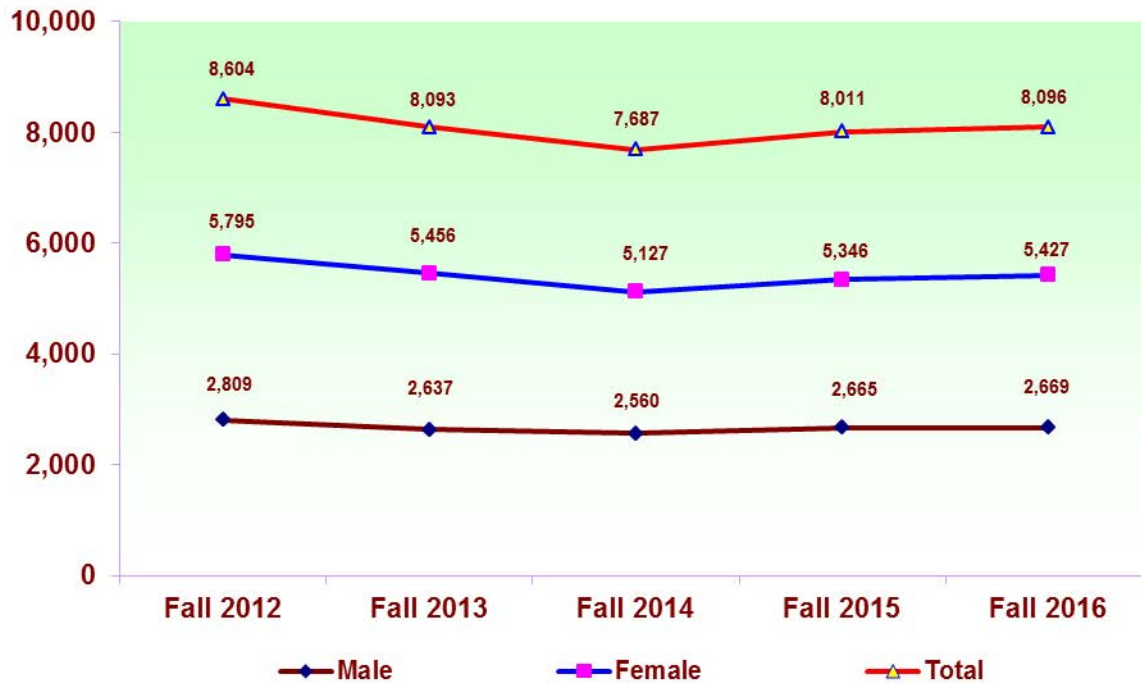

Trend of Student Enrollment Headcount by Gender

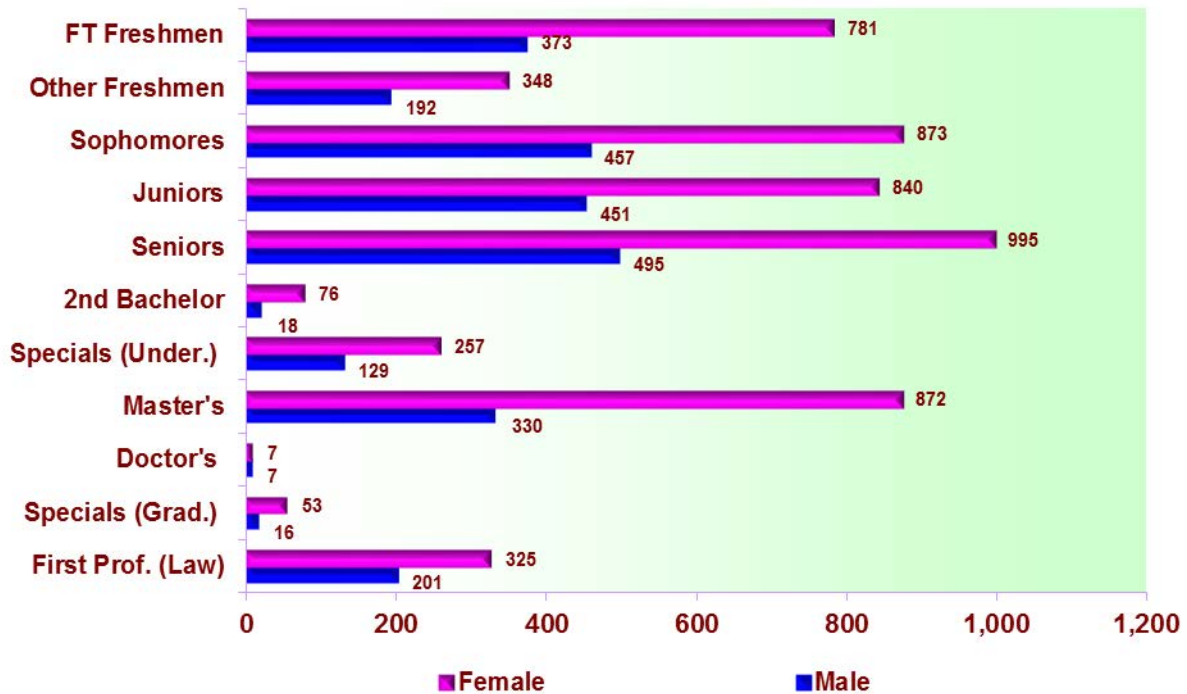

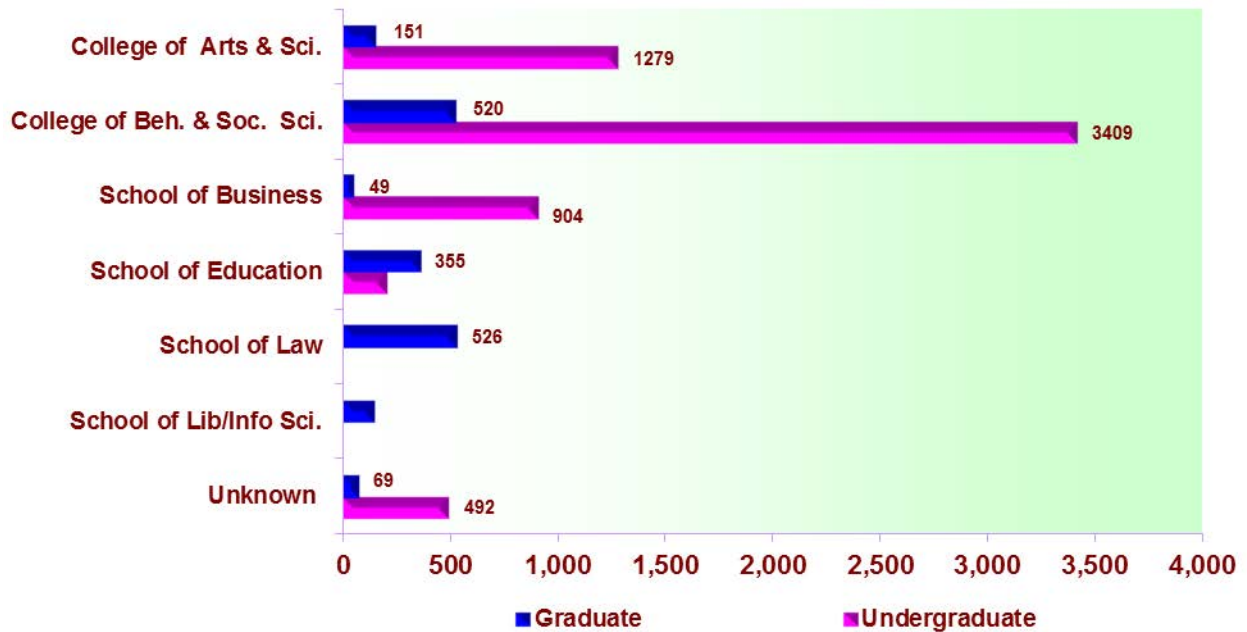

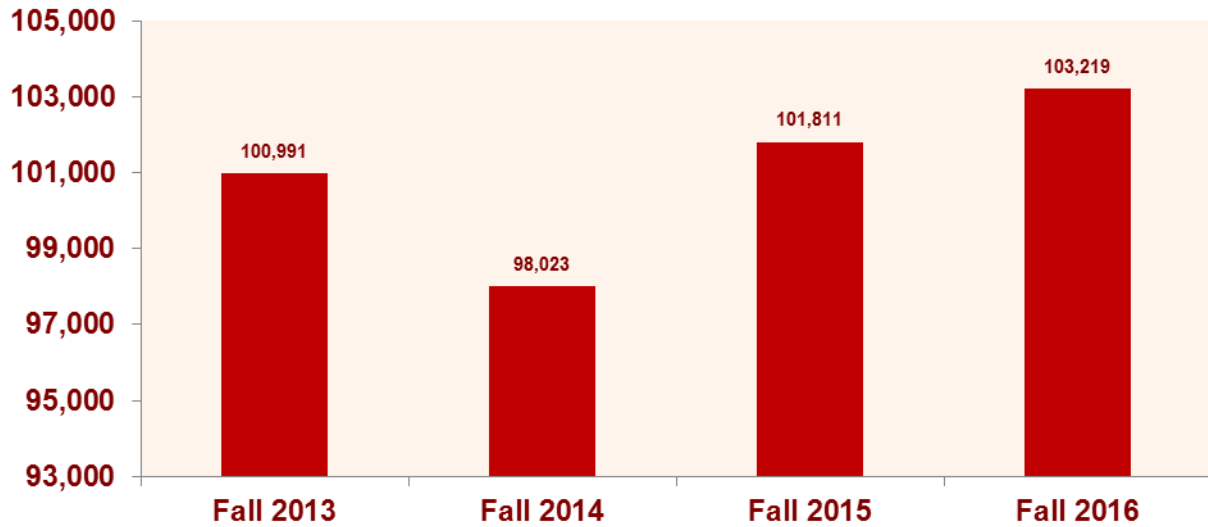

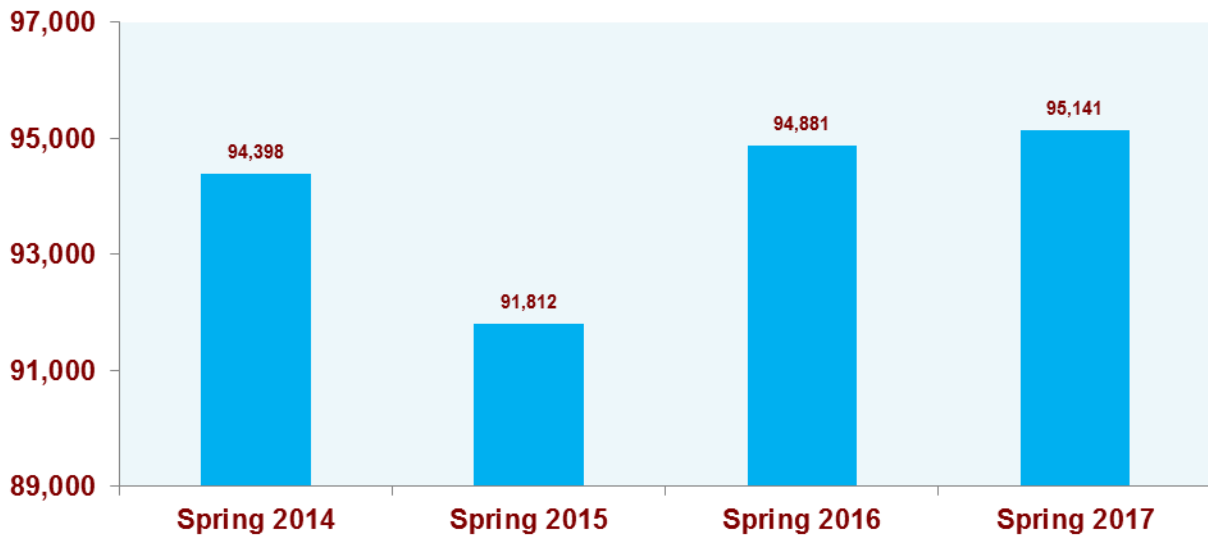
Trend of Total Student Credit Hours

Trend of Total Student Credit Hours

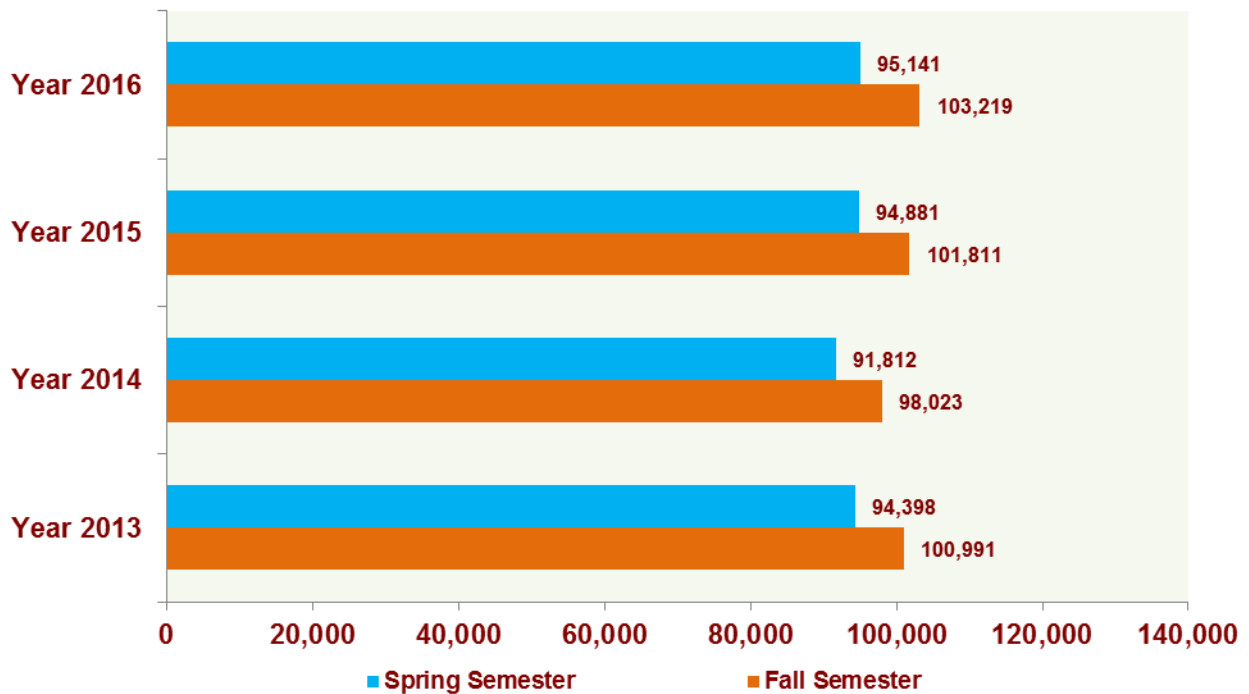

Total Student Credit Hours from Fall 2013 to Spring 2017



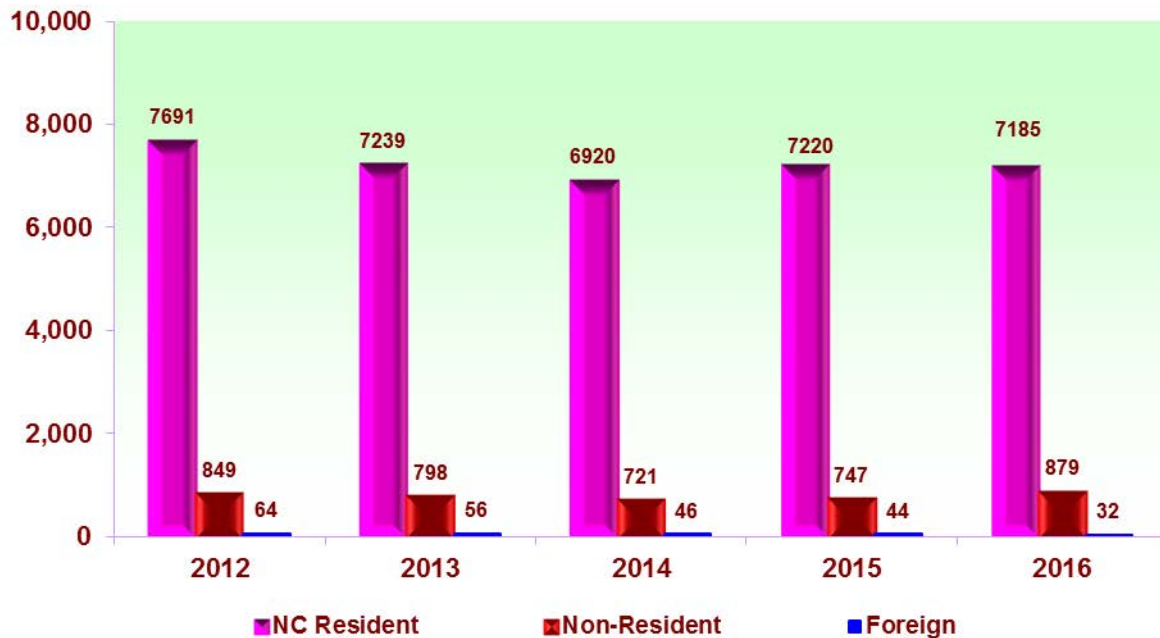

Trend of Student Headcount by Enrollment Category

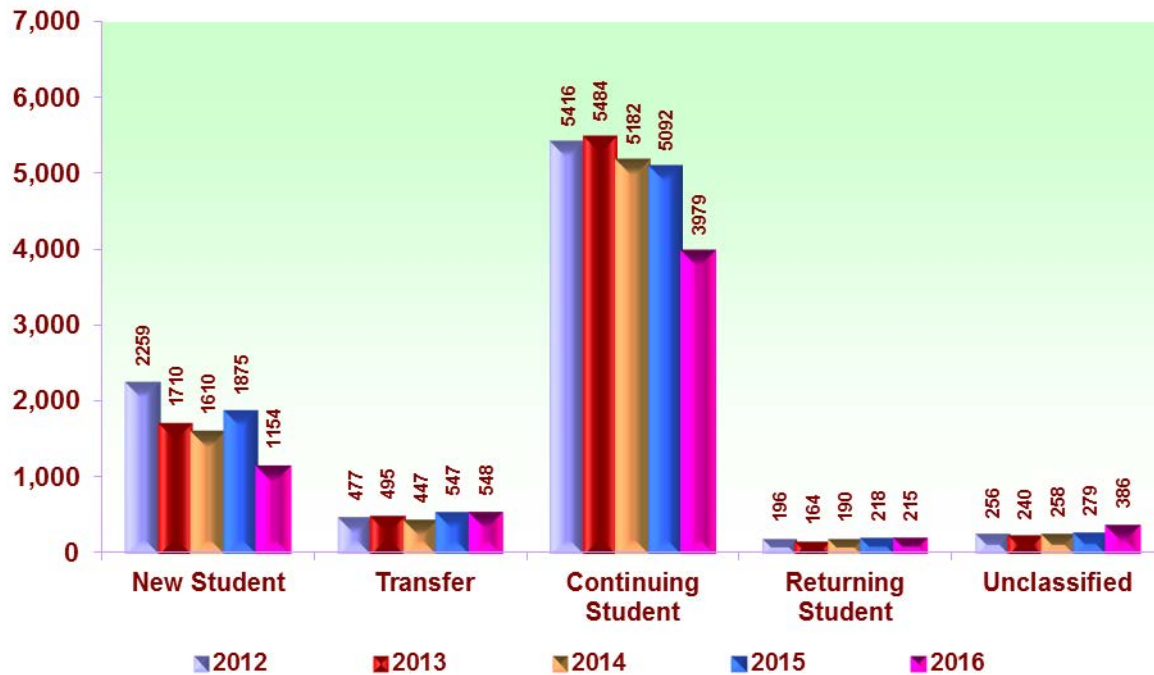
