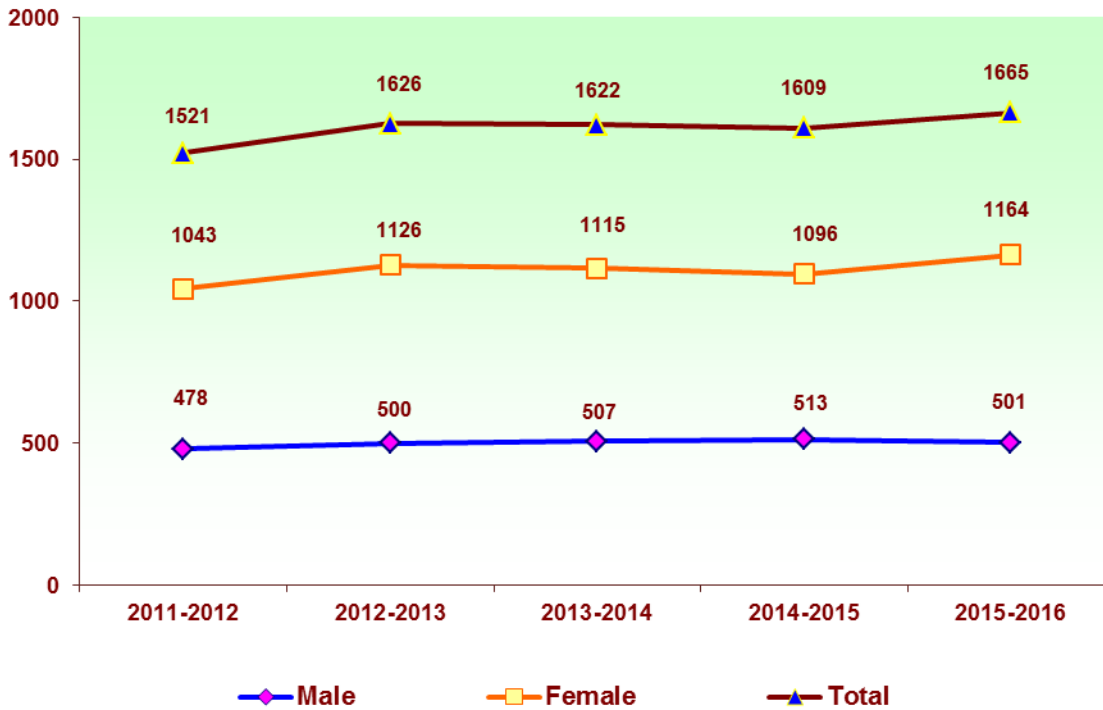

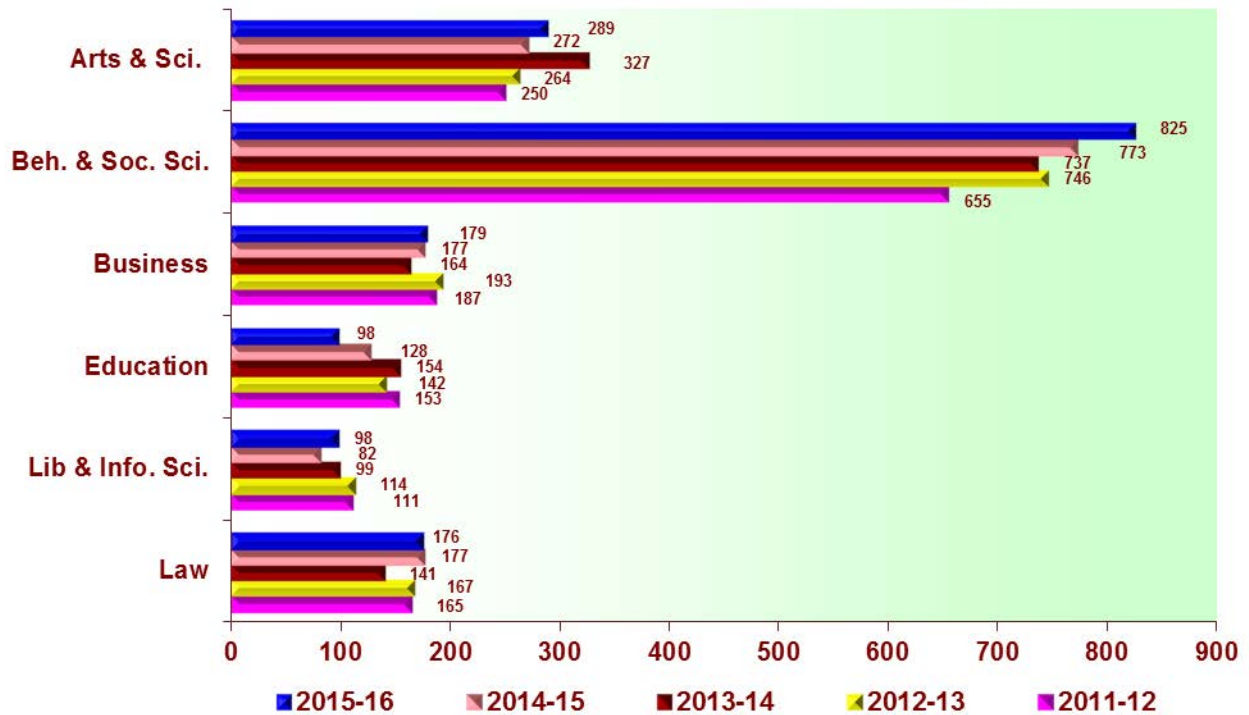

Trend of Total Degrees Awarded by College/School



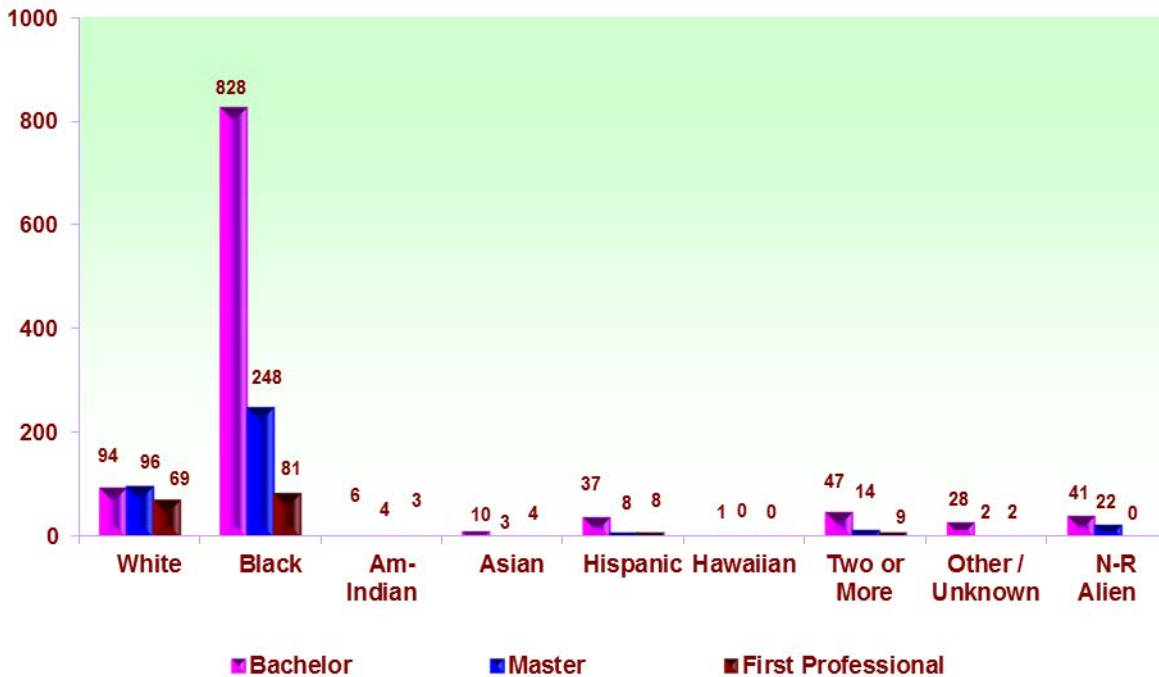
