

UNC System Hurricane Florence Emergency Grant

Students may request for consideration additional funding up to \$1,250, due to Hurricane Florence. The student must have suffered financial hardship due to the damage and destruction from Hurricane Florence. These funds may be used to cover any expenses that support a student's continued enrollment, including costs related to transportation, textbooks, tuition, fees, and living expenses.

Once an application is received and considered complete, it will be reviewed to determine what funds are available for the student submitting the request. The student will receive an acknowledgement that their completed application has been received within 48 hours of submission. If the application is approved, students will receive funding within two weeks of receipt of application.

Eligibility Criteria:

1. The student is enrolled in an UNC System institution at the time of the application
2. The student has a financial need related to the impact of Hurricane Florence
3. The student meets at least one of the following criteria:
 - a. The institution of higher education in which the student was enrolled as of September 10, 2018, is located in a county designated under a major disaster declaration by the President of the United States under the Stafford Act (P.L. 93-288) as a result of Hurricane Florence*.
 - b. The student resided, as of September 10, 2018, temporarily or permanently, in a county designated under a major disaster declaration by the President of the United States under the Stafford Act (P.L. 93-288) as a result of Hurricane Florence Must be enrolled for the Fall 2018 semester at a UNC System Institution*.
4. The student shall use best efforts and take all reasonable steps to obtain alternative funds that cover the losses or needs for he which the emergency scholarship grant funds are provided, including funds from insurance policies in effect and available federal aid
