CHANCELLOR'S AWARD FOR INNOVATION

The **Chancellor's Award for Innovation** recognizes staff and faculty who have made outstanding contributions towards the development of University operational efficiencies, and in improving the effectiveness of a service or program resulting in new or improved innovations that provide cost-savings for NC Central University.

Winner receives:

- A Faculty/Staff 100 Meal Plan with 100 Flex Dollars - Value: \$618.96. This plan offers 100 meals at W.G. Pearson Dining Hall and 100 flex dollars to use at the appropriate dining locations.
- A \$1,000.00 cash award
- A framed certificate and an Eagle lapel pin.

Nominees are required to meet the following eligibility criteria:

- Permanent full-time and part-time SHRA and EHRA employees
- Employed with NC Central University for a minimum of 12 consecutive months
- Nominee must not have any active disciplinary actions
- Acceptable to self-nominate

- Nominator completes the online nomination form and submits prior to deadline
- The Awards Committee receives and reviews nominations per established guidelines
- Selected winners will be mailed an official congratulatory letter
- Winners will be announced by the Chancellor during the August Faculty and Staff Institute

CHANCELLOR'S AWARD FOR EFFECTIVE COMMUNICATION

The **Chancellor's Award for Effective Communications** recognizes the departments of NC Central for their demonstration of proactive communication strategies that embody 'Truth in Service' and Eagle Promise. The winning unit must:

- Exhibit a total commitment to service and to serving the NC Central University community
- Display exceptional dependability and effective relationships with employees and partnering agencies
- Demonstrate high degree of initiative in executing responsibilities
- Contribute unselfish devotion to duty, far and above normal requirements

Winner receives:

- A Chancellor sponsored reception for the entire department
- Every employee in the department receives a framed certificate and an Eagle lapel pin.
- The recipient department receives an engraved plaque.

Nominees are required to meet the following eligibility criteria:

- Open to all NC Central University campus units and departments
- Employees may nominate a staff or faculty member and his/her department respectively
- Nominee must not have active disciplinary actions
- Acceptable to self-nominate

- Nominator completes the online nomination form and submits prior to deadline
- The Awards Committee receives and reviews nominations per established guidelines
- Selected winners will be mailed an official congratulatory letter
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CHANCELLOR'S AWARD FOR STUDENT SERVICE

The **Chancellor's Award for Student Service** recognizes quality service given to students. The staff or faculty member must possess the following qualities:

- Demonstrates the ability to listen, empower and inspire others toward the University vision
- Establishes long-term commitment to influence a positive and measurable impact with regard to the student's success
- Displays exceptional leadership in fostering and promoting student's educational and social development

Winner receives:

- A Faculty/Staff 100 Meal Plan with 100 Flex Dollars - Value: \$618.96. This plan offers 100 meals at W.G. Pearson Dining Hall and 100 flex dollars to use at the appropriate dining locations
- A \$1,000.00 cash award
- A framed certificate and an Eagle lapel pin
- If eligible, winner is nominated for the State of North Carolina Governor's Award

Nominator must be a current STUDENT of NC Central University. The student must be actively enrolled in coursework earning three (3) or more credit hours.

Nominees are required to meet the following eligibility criteria:

- Permanent full-time and part-time SHRA and EHRA employees
- Employed with NC Central University for a minimum of 12 consecutive months
- Nominee must not have active disciplinary actions

- Nominator completes the online nomination form and submits prior to deadline
- The Awards Committee receives and reviews nominations per established guidelines
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- Acceptable to self-nominate

CHANCELLOR'S AWARD FOR RESEARCH

The **Chancellor's Award for Research** recognizes faculty merit for published research, scholarship, or creative expression. The employee whose research quality and quantity are exemplary, and whose work has had a positive influence on the broader community is selected as the award recipient. It is the University's highest honor for research.

Winner receives:

- A Faculty/Staff 100 Meal Plan with 100 Flex Dollars - Value: \$618.96. This plan offers 100 meals at W.G. Pearson Dining Hall and 100 flex dollars to use at the appropriate dining locations.
- A \$1,000.00 cash award
- A framed certificate and an Eagle lapel pin

Faculty nominees are required to meet all of the following eligibility criteria:

- Permanent full-time and part-time SHRA and EHRA employees
- Employed with NC Central University for a minimum of 12 consecutive months
- Employee must not have any active disciplinary actions
- Acceptable to self-nominate

- Nominator completes the online nomination form and submits prior to deadline
- The Awards Committee receives and reviews nominations per established guidelines
- Selected winners will be mailed an official congratulatory letter
- Winners will be announced by the Chancellor during the August Faculty and Staff Institute

CHANCELLOR'S AWARD FOR UNIVERSITY SERVICE

The **Chancellor's Award for University Service** recognizes the exceptional employee whose distinctive service and contributions to the University, student body, and local community far exceeds the scope of their individual accountabilities. This employee exemplifies the vision and mission of NCCU through a profound 'passion to serve.'

In the pursuit and performance of committed service, this employee:

- Excels as a team player
- Continuously contributes to the success of peers and University constituents
- As a role model or mentor captivates all they encounter
- Devotes infinite time and effort on behalf of the University and community

Winner receives:

- A Faculty/Staff 100 Meal Plan with 100 Flex Dollars - Value: \$618.96. This plan offers 100 meals at W.G. Pearson Dining Hall and 100 flex dollars to use at the appropriate dining locations.
- A \$1,000.00 cash award
- A framed certificate and an Eagle lapel pin
