

**ASSESSMENT OF STUDENT LEARNING OUTCOMES

All Council on Social Work Education (CSWE) programs measure and report student learning outcomes. Students are assessed on their mastery of the competencies which comprise the accreditation standards of the Council on Social Work Education. These competencies are dimensions of social work practice which all social workers are expected to master during their professional training. A measurement benchmark is set by the social work programs for each competency. An assessment score at or above that benchmark is considered by the program to represent mastery of that particular competency.

Competency 3: Advance Human Rights and Social, Economic, and Environmental Justice	75% of the students will receive a minimum score of 3 out 5	83%
Competency 4: Engage in Practice-informed Research and Research-informed Practice	75% of the students will receive a minimum score of 3 out 5	73.5%
Competency 5: Engage in Policy Practice	75% of the students will receive a minimum score of 3 out 5	79%
Competency 6: Engage with Individuals, Families, Groups, Organizations, and Communities	75% of the students will receive a minimum score of 3 out 5	92.5%
Competency 7: Assess Individuals, Families, Groups, Organizations, and Communities	75% of the students will receive a minimum score of 3 out 5	74.5%
Competency 8: Intervene with Individuals, Families, Groups, Organizations, and Communities	75% of the students will receive a minimum score of 3 out 5	79%
Competency 9: Evaluate Practice with Individuals, Families, Groups, Organizations, and Communities	75% of the students will receive a minimum score of 3 out 5	71.7%
