



North Carolina Community College Transfer Scholarship Application



North Carolina Central University (NCCU) has established scholarship opportunities for qualified transfer students completing the Associate of Arts, Associate of Science, or Associate of Applied Science Degree programs from a North Carolina Community College. The NCCU Community College Transfer Scholarships are offered to N.C. Community College graduates who received their degree within the past 5 years* and present GPAs in the following ranges:

GPA 2.75 – 3.0	\$2,000 per year
GPA 3.1 – 3.5	\$2,500 per year
GPA 3.6 – 4.0	\$3,000 per year

Application Process:

North Carolina Central University’s Transfer Scholarship is a two-year scholarship for entering North Carolina Community College graduates who have been admitted to NCCU. A student may apply for the scholarship while making application to the University, however, the scholarship application will only be processed after the student is accepted to NCCU.

The transfer scholarship recipient must maintain a minimum 3.00 cumulative GPA while enrolled for two consecutive years (excluding summer school) at NCCU. Students who are awarded a scholarship with a GPA of 2.75 must have a GPA of 3.0 by the start of the 2nd semester in order to maintain the scholarship. The transfer scholarship is offered on a first-come first-serve basis. Thus, not all students who apply are awarded a scholarship. The number of scholarships awarded may vary from year to year. All transfer scholarships are for tuition only; they do not cover the orientation, or any other initial non-refundable deposits, application fees, supplies, or campus residential fees (room and board).

(*Students who completed their degree prior to May 2005 are not eligible for this scholarship)

Transfer students receiving full scholarships from other programs are not eligible for the Transfer Scholarship.

What to submit:

- Completed transfer scholarship application
- Official NC Community College transcript –
 - If you are submitting your application before receiving your final community college transcript, you may submit an unofficial transcript showing your current GPA. A decision on your acceptance will not be determined until the official transcript is received and reviewed. The final transcript must be received by the deadline date.
- 500 word hand-written essay – Topic: **Based on your educational journey to this point, what positive experiences have prepared you to complete your Bachelors Degree at North Carolina Central University?**
- Interview – interview will be scheduled after completed application packet is received and will take place on campus.
