College of Arts and Sciences Committee Responsibilities

COLLEGE CHAIRS' COUNCIL

The Chairs' Council meets on a monthly basis and handles all academic matters in the College. Membership includes all department Chairs, Program Directors, Associate Dean and is chaired by the Dean.

COLLEGE REAPPOINTMENT, PROMOTION AND TENURE COMMITTEE

The committee reviews portfolios of applicants for reappointment, promotion, tenure and post-tenure and makes recommendations to the Dean regarding the approval or disapproval of the request.

COLLEGE CURRICULUM COMMITTEE

The curriculum committee reviews all recommendations for new courses, new programs and other curricular changes requested by departments in the College of Arts and Sciences. The committee insures that information received complies with guidelines for curricular changes and recommends approval or disapproval of recommendations to the Chair's Council.

CAS ASSESSMENT COMMITTEE

The Assessment Committee includes point-persons for assessment for each CAS department especially in regards to SACS reaffirmation process. This group provides leadership for the development and implementation of assessment plans for their departments and overall for the College. They oversee program learning outcomes, collect and analyze departmental data, upload and maintain departmental data on Weave-On-Line.

CAS GRADE APPEALS BOARD – UNDERGRADUATE STUDENTS

This committee handles students' grade appeals and alleged unfair or improper treatment in academic matters that have not been resolved at the departmental level.

CAS GRADUATE COUNCIL

The Graduate Committee handles all graduate matters in the college with a broad role that includes recruitment of graduate students, enrollment and retention of graduate students, and other matters that affect graduate education.

CAS FACULTY SGS COUNCIL REPRESENTATIVES

These faculty members represent the College on the School of Graduate Studies Council on graduate policy matters.

INTEGRATED BIOSCIENCES (PHD) COMMITTEE

These faculty members work with the Director of the INBS Ph.D. program on curricular matters for the INBS program. They have oversight of courses and degree requirements for the program. The role is detailed in the INBS Handbook. The CAS Dean and the SGS Dean are ex-officio members of this committee.
