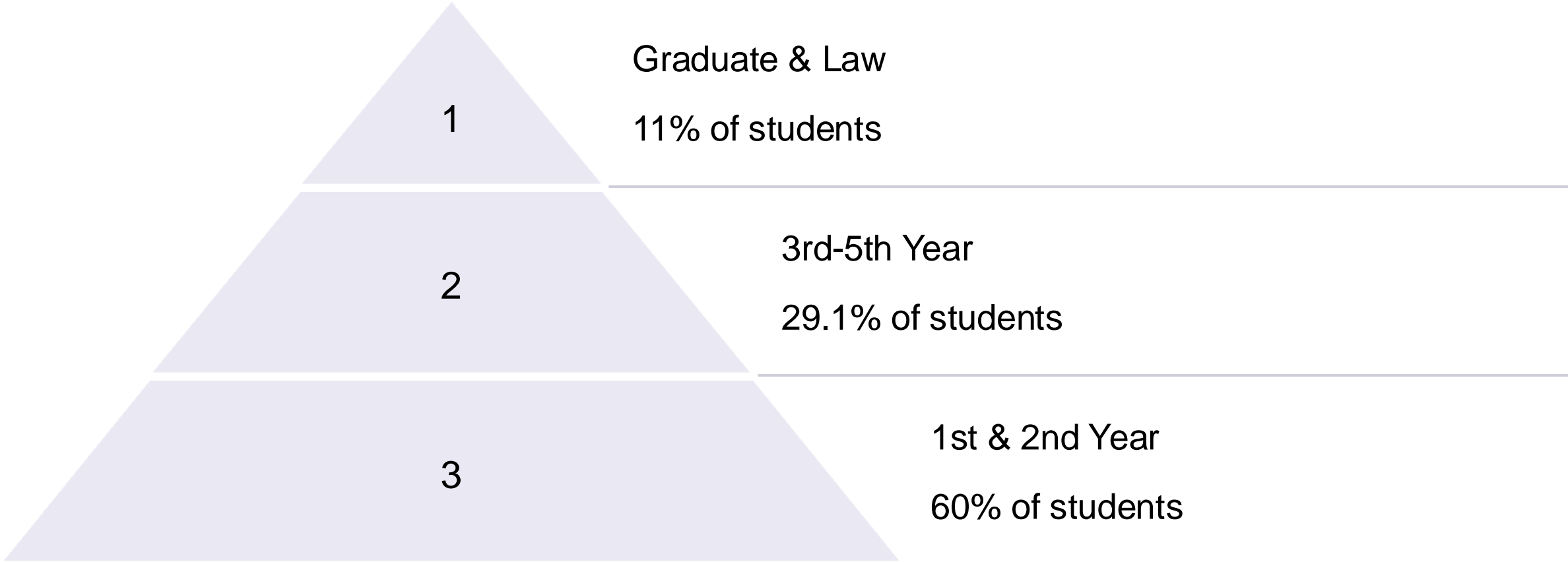

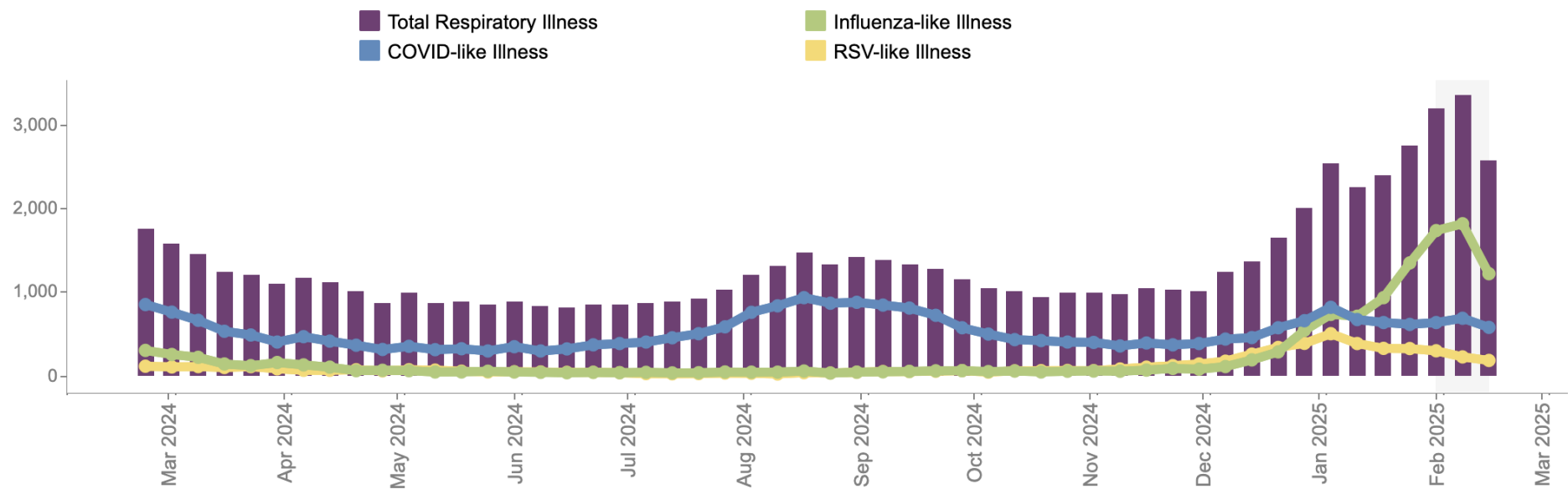




2024-2025 Respiratory Season

Latest week: There were **2,570 hospital admissions** from the emergency department for people who were diagnosed with or had symptoms of a respiratory virus. This includes, but is not limited to, Influenza, RSV or COVID-19. This is a **decrease** from the week before. (The week before was 3,371 hospital admissions from the emergency department)

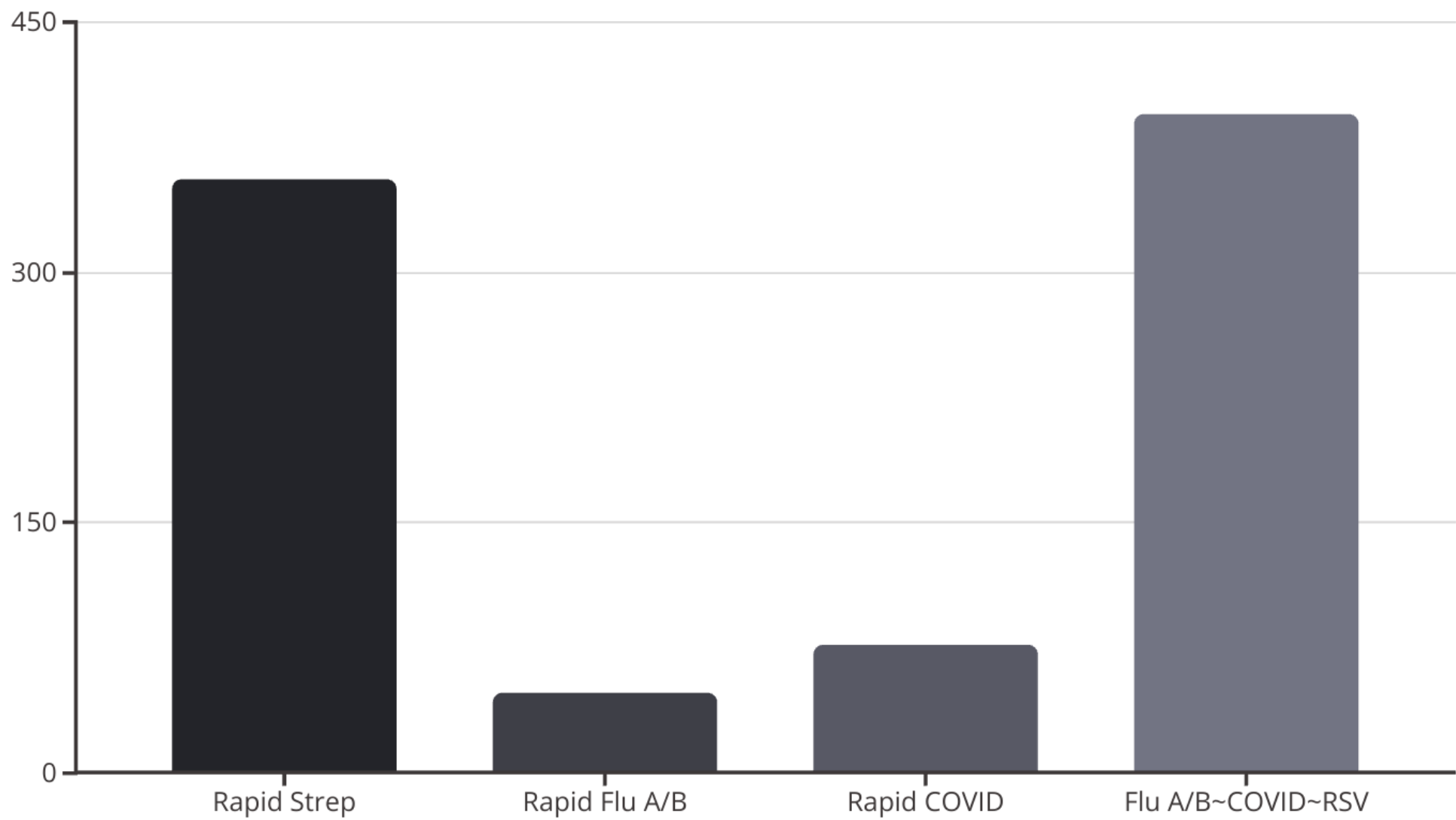


Number of North Carolina hospital admissions from the emergency department with symptoms or a diagnosis of a respiratory virus. [More info](#)
