

Commission for Public Higher Education Accreditation (CPHE)

- Founded by six university systems the State University System of Florida, the University System of Georgia, the University of North Carolina System, the University of South Carolina System, the Texas A&M University System, and the University of Tennessee System.
- Institutional accrediting agency for state public colleges and universities that award associates, bachelor's, and/or higher degrees.
- Guided by core principles:
 - A return to true peer-review for publics, by publics
 - A focus on student outcomes, not inputs
 - A reduction of unnecessary bureaucracy, opacity, and expense
- CPHE will submit an application for recognition to the U.S. Department of Education in late 2027.

Accomplishments


- Completed 3-year planning and development phase

- 2025 Annual Report






